Event Schedule:

The Friends of Page-Walker Herbfest will be held RAIN OR SHINE on Saturday, May 7, 2023 from 12:00 AM – 4:00 PM. In case of inclement weather, the Festival will be held inside the Page-Walker Arts & History Center. Setup begins at 10:30 AM on Sunday and must be completed by 11:30 AM. Tear down may begin after the Herbfest closes at 4:00 PM.

Vendor Fees:

Vendor fees are \$40.00. There is no fee for those vendors who do not sell any products and wish, instead, to perform a demonstration involving gardening or those organizations providing education.

Selection:

Food/craft vendors are asked to reflect the theme of the Herbfest, which is centered on gardening, herbs, native plants, perennials, nature, cooking, and the contribution these pursuits make to a healthy lifestyle.

Booth:

The booth dimensions are 10' x 10' and include a pop-up tent without sides. Vendors should keep their displays within this space. One six-foot table will also be provided; if a vendor would like additional table, they may bring one. Two chairs will also be provided. *Information on parking, unloading and the location of your booth space will be sent to you with your confirmation prior to the event.*

There are a limited number of tents; a request for an additional tent (and accompanying fee) will be considered on a first-come basis.

Personnel:

Participating vendors shall provide adequate personnel for the day.

Food Vendors:

All food vendors must comply with Wake County Health Regulations. You must make prior arrangement for all certificates and inspections, if needed. The Wake County Health Department's phone number is (919) 856-7400 or www.wake.gov.com – click on Food Safety and Facility Inspections.

<u>Insurance/Liability:</u> All food vendors must submit a current Certificate of Liability Insurance covering the date of the Herbfest and listing the Town of Cary as additional named insured.
